Making a Call

(5) Basic Phone Functions

You can make a call by pressing the Hands-free key or picking up the handset:

- Dial the phone number with the number key pad
- Dial one of your emergency contacts Mi Speed dial keys (M1 M5)
- Dial Redial key for the last dialled phone number

Answering a Call

You answer an incoming call these ways:

- Lift the handset to answer
- Press Hands-free
- Press you EG201 button
- If you are on another call, press Flash key to answer it

Mi Speed Dial Keys

You press M1, M2, M3, M4 and M5 keys to speed dial your emergency personal contact phone numbers.

Flash Key

You press the Flash key while you are on the phone:

- Answer an incoming call (incoming call tone)
- Talk with a call waiting (call waiting tone)

Pause Key

Insert a pause before the extension for redialing purpose.

Example: 8773338934, pause, 555, hang up and redial.

Redial Key

You redial the last dialled phone number.

Volume Adjustment

During a call, you can press the volume adjustment keys to adjust the volume.

(6) EG Programing Function Keys

EG function keys are used as following:

- Sync key changes EG100 unit parameters such as Mi speed dial keys
- Pair key adds or deletes EG201 buttons



1 Home Monitoring

For HELP, you can:

- Press any EG201 button (<u>watch</u>, <u>pendant</u>, <u>pull cord</u> or <u>wall press box</u>)
- Press EG100 unit red Emergency button

(2) Cancel Key

You can use the Cancel key to stop a processing emergency call for HELP or ending EG Function keys Sync and Pair.

(3) Power Green LED

Steady green LED is EG100 unit power on and no green LED is power off.

(3) Ready Amber LED

Blinking amber LED is EG100 unit monitoring on and no amber LED is monitoring off (unsupervised).

(3) Off Hook Red LED

The phone line steady red LED happens once:

- You lift the handset or press the Hands-free key
- The EG100 unit communicates for emergency or supervision
